

Culture and Identity

Goal: Students will write a *journal form* response to a brief history of the Coast Salish People.

Definitions:

1. **Cultural identity** is a person's self-concept and is related to nationality, ethnicity, religion, social class, locality, or generation.
2. **Culture** is the ideas, customs, and social behaviours
3. **Identity** is how a person feels about what a person is and the characteristics describing a person's culture

Journal form is a first-person response that employs personal opinions to analyze content; non-explicit colloquial phrasing is appropriate.
