Simple Recipes Cultural Identity Speech

Goal: Students will create a 30-second speech recognizing 2 points about their own cultural identity.

Curricular competencies: Students will practise using expressive language to communicate their personal thoughts on their cultural background and how it relates to the world around them.

DEFINITIONS:

- 1. **Cultural identity** is a person's self-concept and is related to nationality, ethnicity, religion, social class, locality, or generation.
- 2. **Culture** is the ideas, customs, and social behaviours
- 3. **Identity** is how a person feels about what a person is and the characteristics describing a person's culture

Criteria:

Student Checklist

- 1. Clarify your topic and title
- 2. Make eye contact with the camera for at least 15 of the seconds
- 3. You can use script to remind yourself of the main points
- 5. Use and explain who/what are your sources
- 6. End with a point that resonates with your audience

Beyond the Checklist

- 1. Rather than creating several small points, weave together supporting points that support your main point
- 2. Begin with an engaging first sentence
- 3. Memorize the entire speech (30 seconds)
- 4. Use engaging facial and body gestures
- 5. Use primary/first-hand knowledge/sources
- 6. Use a metaphor that encapsulates your speech, like Madeleine Thien used washing rice to explain her fading culture

Turn in assignment:

- 1. Students must submit their script to Teams
- 2. Students must submit a video recording of the speech to Teams

Optional:

If you feel extremely uncomfortable discussing your cultural identity, send me a message on Teams by Monday May 18 and I will assign you a different topic. The due date and criteria will be the same.
